IN RE: HB1687 by Dutton (Relating to fees charged by a juvenile justice alternative education program.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would add Section 37.012(e) to the Texas Education Code to prohibit a juvenile justice alternative education program from charging fees for participation in the program.
