**IN RE: HB1793** by Naishtat (Relating to the jurisdiction of a court with respect to an action involving a testamentary trust.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Probate Code to specify in which courts an action involving a testamentary trust shall be filed. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005 and would apply only to actions filed on or after that date.

**Local Government Impact**

It is anticipated that the potential shift in which courts in which testamentary trust actions are filed would have an insignificant fiscal impact on the affected courts.
