No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Penal Code by changing the offense of attack on an assistance animal to assault on an assistance animal. It is assumed that the number of offenders convicted under this statute would not result in a significant impact on the programs and workload of state corrections agencies or on the demand for resources and services of those agencies.
