No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code relating to requirements for a person to notify the public of intent to apply for the passage of a law that would establish a municipal management district. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives the required two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2005.
