IN RE: HB1892 by Eiland (Relating to excluding a challenge course used for educational purposes from regulation as an amusement ride.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to excluding a challenge course used for educational purposes from regulation as an amusement ride. The Department of Insurance anticipates any additional work resulting from the passage of the bill could be reasonably absorbed within current resources.

This bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
