IN RE: HB1970 by Raymond (Relating to reports and investigations of child abuse and neglect.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Family Code to add the superintendent of the school district to the person who should receive a report of the Department of Family Protective Service's investigation.

It is assumed that new or expanded responsibilities could be absorbed within existing resources.
