IN RE: HB1999 by Van Arsdale (Relating to the preparation of medical history reports by parents who relinquish children for adoption.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Department of Family and Protective Services to adopt a medical history disclosure form for persons who voluntarily relinquish parental rights regarding a biological child. The agency indicates that this can be accomplished within existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
