IN RE: HB2110 by Berman (Relating to the applicability of certain weapon laws to certain prosecutors.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would exempt a district attorney and a criminal district attorney who is licensed to carry a concealed handgun from applicability of Sections 46.02 (Unlawful Carrying Weapons) and 46.03 (Places Weapons Prohibited) of the Penal Code.
