IN RE: HB2140 by Phillips (Relating to the provision of notice to affected political subdivisions regarding the proposed construction of a reservoir.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require that an application for a permit to construct a storage reservoir must include evidence that each member of the governing body of each county and municipality in which the reservoir would be located was notified by the permit applicant of the intent to request a permit. Evidence of that notification would be required to be included in an application for the permit submitted to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
