**IN RE: HB2145** by Hupp (Relating to prohibiting changes in certain prescription drug orders without the approval of the prescribing health care practitioner.), **As Engrossed** 

## No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would prohibit pharmacist from changing a drug or medication prescribed by a practitioner, without approval of that practitioner, for participants in a health care plan managed by the Employees Retirement System or by the Teacher Retirement System. The bill would exempt generic substitutions.

### **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
