**IN RE: HB2172** by West, George "Buddy" (Relating to eligibility for a license or registration for an exemption to engage in liquified petroleum gas-related activities and to disciplinary action against licensees and registrants ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would allow the Railroad Commission to effectively prohibit licensees and registrants for exemptions that have not resolved violations from continuing to conduct liquefied petroleum gas-related activities. No significant increase in the Railroad Commission's workload is expected.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
