**IN RE: HB2241** by Callegari (Relating to the authority of certain municipalities to require a contract between a municipal utility district and the municipality before the district issues obligations.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would repeal authorization for a city to provide in its written consent for the inclusion of land in a district that an allocation agreement contract between a municipal utility district and the municipality be entered into prior to the first issue of bonds, notes, warrants, or other obligations.
