IN RE: HB2266 by Baxter (Relating to the authority of municipalities to enact requirements that establish the sales price or limit the eligible buyers for certain housing units or residential lots.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would prohibit a municipality from adopting a requirement in any form that would establish a sales price for a privately produced housing unit or residential building lot as a condition for granting a building permit. If a requirement exists that would violate the provisions of the bill, that requirement would become void on the effective date of the bill, which would be September 1, 2005.

Local Government Impact
