IN RE: HB2301 by Turner (Relating to proceedings involving the change of rates of a water and sewer utility.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Water Code relating to procedures that a local regulatory authority that regulates a utility must follow when a utility seeks a rate change. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
