**IN RE: HB2375** by McClendon (Relating to the issuance of bonds or other obligations by certain junior college districts.), **As Introduced** 

### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would authorize a junior college district that has a total headcount enrollment of 40,000 or more based on enrollment in the most recent regular semester to issue bonds or other obligations to finance certain public improvements.
