IN RE: HB2540 by Davis, John (Relating to the term of a food manager certificate.), As Introduced

## No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill amends Chapter 12 of the Health and Safety Code. The bill exempts the food manager certificate from the 2-year renewal period. Because of the number of new licenses issued each year (caused by industry turnover) there is no fiscal impact to revenues or costs.
