**IN RE: HB2684** by Gallego (Relating to the prohibition of glass containers within the boundaries of a state-owned riverbed; providing penalties. ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would prohibit glass containers within state-owned riverbeds. Costs to enforce this provision are expected to be absorbed within existing state agency resources.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
