IN RE: HB2758 by Bonnen (Relating to certain permitting procedures of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would make various changes to procedures relating to contested-case hearings on permit applications to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). None of the changes are expected to result in significant changes in workload to the (TCEQ) or to the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
