IN RE: HB2920 by Kuempel (Relating to the regulatory authority of groundwater conservation districts, underground water conservation districts, and other districts and authorities authorized to regulate the spacing of water wells, the production from water wells, or both.), As Introduced

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would restrict a groundwater conservation district to adopting rules that would reduce the amount of groundwater that may be produced when regulating the spacing wells and production of groundwater. The rules must be based on sound hydrogeologic science.

Local Government Impact
