IN RE: HB2995 by King, Tracy (relating to a person who is entitled to claim a lien on certain assets.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would include staff leasing services companies whose employees perform public work labor to fulfill an obligation to a prime contractor or to a subcontractor within the definition of subcontractor.
