**IN RE: HB3045** by Kolkhorst (Relating to the juvenile boards of Grimes, Leon, Madison, and Walker Counties.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

The bill would amend the Human Resources Code to require the commissioners court in Grimes, Leon, Madison, and Walker counties to pay the juvenile board members not less than \$1,200 annually. The bill would also change the composition of the Leon County juvenile board.

The bill would take effect immediately if it receives the required two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2005.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
