**IN RE: HB3113** by Corte (Relating to performance incentive awards for certain employees of state agencies who provide services to veterans.), **As Engrossed**

The bill would amend Chapter 659 of the Government Code to allow a state agency make a performance incentive award to a classified employee for providing services to veterans. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
