IN RE: HB3122 by Giddings (Relating to prohibiting the sale or possession of a device that vaporizes alcoholic beverages for the purpose of inhalation; providing criminal penalties.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code making it a Class C misdemeanor to sell or possess a device that vaporizes alcoholic beverages for the purpose of allowing the alcoholic beverages to be inhaled.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
