**IN RE: HB3150** by Escobar (Relating to protection of animal shelters from fireworks.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would create as a Class C misdemeanor the act of exploding or igniting fireworks within 600 feet of an animal shelter.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated from enforcement, prosecution, or punishment of the offense.
