IN RE: HB3198 by Hope (Relating to a revision of the procedures for municipal annexation in certain municipalities.), **Committee Report 1st House, As Amended**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would revise the procedures required for municipal annexation, establishing certain procedures in municipalities with a population under 45,000. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives the required two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2005.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
