**IN RE: HB3312** by Anderson (Relating to the establishment of a site-based school discipline policy committee under Subchapter F, Chapter 11, Education Code.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would establish a site-based school discipline policy committee made up of full-time teachers on the campus. The bill would also repeal Education Code, Section 37.003 regarding the role and authority of the placement review committee.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated. Local procedures would likely need some modification as a result of the repeal of discipline placement review committees.
