IN RE: HB3434 by Hartnett (Relating to testamentary and nontestamentary transfers of property and other benefits and the administration of those benefits.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Probate Code to allow the court to appoint appraisers of the estate property upon its own motion, or the motion of an interested party.
