IN RE: HJR11 by Branch (Proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the determination of a quorum of the senate or house of representatives.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$66,497.

The joint resolution would redefine a quorum of each house of the legislature as being a majority of the members instead of two-thirds of the members.
