IN RE: HJR72 by Geren (Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to exempt the residence homesteads of certain totally disabled veterans from ad valorem taxation.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$66,497.

The joint resolution by itself has no fiscal impact, as it grants the legislature the ability, via separate legislation, to exempt certain property.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
