IN RE: HJR82 by Hughes (Relating to a constitutional amendment clearing land titles by relinquishing and releasing any state claim to sovereign ownership or title to interest in certain land.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$66,497.

The resolution proposes a constitutional amendment relinquishing claims of State ownership or title to certain tracts of land, including mineral rights, in Upshur and Smith Counties.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
