### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The Texas Department of Insurance anticipates any additional work resulting from the passage of the bill could be accomplished with existing resources. The Texas Department of Insurance's Life, Health, and Health Maintenance Organization sections report that there may be an increase of new form filings by insurers and Health Maintenance Organizations.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
