IN RE: SB189 by Zaffirini (Relating to the operation of the Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired estimates that 50 special education teachers would earn a yearly assignment stipend of \$1,000, with an annual cost, including benefits, of \$64,870.
