**IN RE: SB220** by Carona (Relating to the maintenance of records by a notary public.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill amends the Government Code to allow a notary public to keep a notary record book in an electronic format. Any costs to maintain related electronic records are anticipated to be minimal.
