**IN RE: SB221** by Zaffirini (Relating to the possession and self-administration of certain prescription medications by public school students while on school property or at a school-related event or activity. ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would authorize students to possess and self-administer anaphylaxis medication while on school property or at a school-related event.

**Local Government Impact**

School districts would be required to allow affected students possess and self-administer anaphylaxis medication; however, no significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
