IN RE: SB374 by Jackson, Mike (Relating to the repeal of the statutory provision regarding the adoption and use by the Texas Water Development Board of a capital spending plan for certain state-funded water-related programs under the board's jurisdiction.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would repeal Water Code, Section 6.110, which requires the Water Development Board to prepare a Capital Spending Plan to be submitted to the Legislative Budget Board and Governor by January 1 of each odd numbered year. Although the agency would experience some cost savings as a result of this requirement being removed, that savings is not expected to be significant.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
