IN RE: SB424 by Carona (Relating to the deadline for passing the examination for a license to practice medicine in this state.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would take effect immediately upon receiving a two-thirds majority vote in each house. If the bill does not receive a two-thirds vote in each house, the bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
