IN RE: SB531 by West, Royce (Relating to the tuition charged for certain courses repeated by students attending public junior colleges.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Passage of the bill would not have fiscal impact on the state. Tuition revenue, along with ad valorem tax collections, is considered a part of the local contribution of community colleges and will not affect General Revenue Appropriations.
