IN RE: SB588 by Jackson, Mike (Relating to the publication of notice of intent to obtain a permit from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for a facility located or proposed to be located in certain populous counties.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Provisions of the bill would apply only to a county with a population of 3.2 million or more. According to the 2000 federal census, only Harris County meets the population criteria.

Local Government Impact

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House/Senate as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
