IN RE: SB642 by Lucio (Relating to offenses involving use of safety belts or a child passenger safety seat.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code making an offense involving the use of a safety belt or a child passenger safety seat a moving violation of a traffic law. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
