IN RE: SB784 by Shapleigh (Relating to the acceptance by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality of certain emissions reductions in exchange for other emissions reductions.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would expand the ability of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to authorize or allow substitution of emissions reductions. The bill's passage is not expected to result in significant changes to the agency's workload.
