IN RE: SB787 by Williams (Relating to the eligibility of certain organizations to join a risk pool established by a political subdivision for the purpose of providing uniform group benefits.),
As Introduced

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would change the definition of "affiliated service contractor" as it relates to eligibility of certain organizations to join a risk pool established by a political subdivision for the purpose of providing uniform group benefits. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives the required two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2005.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
