**IN RE: SB848** by Shapiro (Relating to the approval of certain permit applications by local governments.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the definition of permit under Section 245.001, Local Government Code to include a contract or other agreement for the construction or provision of utilities and "any...[required] condition precedent." In addition, the bill would expand the purpose for which a local government may review an application for the permit.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated from proposed changes in administrative duties.
