IN RE: SB988 by Carona (relating to education courses required for a mortgage broker or loan officer license.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The Savings and Loan Department indicates that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed within existing resources.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
