**IN RE: SB1242** by Madla (Relating to the procedures required for a governmental entity to perform construction-related work on facilities under the construction manager-agent method.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code relating to when a governmental entity shall select or designate an engineer or architect in relationship to when the entity selects a construction manager-agent for facilities work.
