**IN RE: SB1435** by Madla (Relating to the numbering of emergency services districts converted from rural fire prevention districts.), **As Introduced** 

### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would remove the requirement that the numbering of an emergency services district that was converted from a rural fire prevention district be consecutive, and would require instead that the numbering be sufficient to distinguish one district from another. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.

#### **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
