IN RE: SB1471 by Whitmire (relating to the regulation of certain promotional activities conducted by alcoholic beverage permit and license holders.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code as it relates to the regulation of certain promotional activities conducted by alcoholic beverage permit and license holders.

The bill would delete certain sections of the Alcoholic Beverage Code requiring that a promotion be conducted in 30 or more states before a permittee may offer prizes, premiums, gifts, or sweepstakes.

The bill would take effective September 1, 2005.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
