**IN RE: SB1498** by Fraser (Relating to the requirement for water district consent to certain actions by municipalities that provide law enforcement or fire protection services.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

The bill would add Section 49.237 to Chapter 49 of the Water Code to prohibit an area within a district as described in the bill from being included without the consent of the district in the boundaries of a municipality that provides law enforcement or fire protection services. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives the required two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2005.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
