**IN RE: SB1533** by Barrientos (Relating to state employees parking in state-owned garages.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

This bill would amend the Transportation Code and provide that any lease of a state-owned parking garage must provide that a state employee would be allowed to park in a state owned parking garage free of charge.
