IN RE: SJR20 by West, Royce (Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the governor to grant a pardon to a person who successfully completes a term of deferred adjudication community supervision.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$66,497.

The bill would amend the Texas Constitution to authorize the governor to grant a pardon to a person who successfully completes a term of deferred adjudication community supervision.
