Amend CSHB 1 in Article II by adding the following appropriately numbered rider (on page \_\_\_\_) after the appropriations to the Dept. of State Health Services:

Rider 6381. Family Planning Services at Federally Qualified Health Centers: Out of funds appropriated in Strategy B.1.3, Family Planning Services, up to \$10,000,000 in each year of the 2008-09<del>2006-07</del> biennium shall be set aside for family planning services provided by Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs). The Department shall implement this provision only to the extent that it will not have an adverse affect on the number of women served by the family planning program, especially in underserved areas of the state and areas where no FQHC is available. In addition, up to \$1,000,000 per year may be allocated to clinics for core family planning services provided under the auspices of Baylor College of Medicine. Funds will be allocated statewide to counties for family planning services according to DSHS' annual assessment of women-in-need and on the contractor's ability to utilize their full allocation effectively. Any funds not applied for and granted to FQHCs each fiscal year shall be made available to non-FQHC contractors grantees. FQHCs funded under this strategy shall assure that recipients receive comprehensive primary and preventive care in addition to the family planning services. The Department of State Health Services shall work with FQHC contractors grantees to assure that reporting requirements are aligned with FQHC eligibility, payment and reporting requirements.
